GRANTVILLE & DISTRICT GETS ITS OWN VOICE

Grantville and District is to get its own voice with the launch of The Waterline News on September 15.

The Waterline News will cover the area from Lang Lang through Nyora, Loch, Kernot, The Gurdies, Pioneer Bay, Grantville, Corinella, French Island, Coronet Bay and Glen Forbes.

Production will be completely independent, on a not for profit basis, with accounts audited each year and any surplus, after expenses, distributed to local community organisations and projects through the Grantville and District Residents and Ratepayers Association.

Distribution and content of the Waterline News starts at Lang Lang because we believe there is a significant benefit from the two towns working more closely together.

Lang Lang provides the nearest supermarket facilities for most Grantville and district residents along with a range of specialty shops which are not available, and compliment those, we now have in Grantville.

All local Community Groups will have a listing in The Waterline News with the opportunity to promote their special events.

There will also be the opportunity for Community Centres at Lang Lang and Corinella to promote their activities, and we will also welcome news from the Bass Valley Community Centre. Even though it is outside of our target area it's facilities and programs are used by many residents in the Grantville and District area.

The Waterline News needs the support of advertisers


within the area to cover production expenses and needs you to support our local businesses in return.


